#### **Keep in mind:**

Every scholarship application will ask for a **personal essay** but only **some** will ask for at least one **letter of recommendation**. Read each application **thoroughly** to ensure you **meet all requirements** and **complete** each step of whichever application you **submit**

**Essay Guidelines:** 500-800 word essay describing the following items.

- A brief biography of yourself including your academic and career goals and why have you decided to pursue these goals.
- Participation in activities at school, in clubs, or community service organizations and how it contributed to the organization and to your personal growth.
- Why you are applying for a scholarship and why you should be given one. Include any special circumstances (such as financial need or family situations that the selection committee should consider).

#### ***Letters of Recommendation:***

These letters should be from individuals who can speak to your academic potential and career goals. It is suggested that letters be from a professional source such as school, work, ministry, etc.

# INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

-SPRING 2017-

**Deadline to apply: November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016**

**CCA Advance Scholarship:** Must have a cumulative **3.5 GPA**, be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours, have not yet earned a Bachelor's degree, be a Colorado resident. Recent high school graduates or GED recipients may also qualify, see application for details \*\*

**CCA Aurorian Scholarship:** Must be in first semester following an **absence of at least three years** from formal education, be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours, have not yet earned a Bachelor's degree, be a Colorado resident \*\*

**CCA Colorado Merit Aid Award:** Must have a cumulative **2.75 GPA** or higher, be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours, have not yet earned a Bachelor's degree, be a Colorado resident. Recent high school graduates or GED recipients may qualify, see application for details \*\*

**Daniel's Boundless Opportunity Scholarship:** Designed for adult students age 25 or older nearing degree completion\*\*

**CCA Launch Your Future Scholarship:** Must have **graduated from High School within the last 24 months** with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, or earned a GED within the last 24 months with a Battery Average of 570 or higher. Must be in your first semester of college coursework, be in your first semester at CCA, be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours, have not earned a Bachelor's degree, be a Colorado resident \*\*

**CCA Senior Citizen Grant:** Must be a Colorado resident and **60 years or older**. 50% Discount on resident Tuition (max 12 credits per semester)\*\*\*
