

2021-22 GT Transfer Course Guide

gtPathways is a set of general education courses that the state guarantees to transfer. The curriculum consists of **31 credit hours** of courses across **6 content areas (Communication, Mathematics, Arts & Humanities, History, Social & Behavioral Sciences, Natural & Physical Sciences)**. Receiving institutions shall apply guaranteed general education courses to a student's general education or major requirements.
